20. 08-2013 Learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the matter is still pending and hence this Court disposes of the matter on merits. The Petitioner seeks quashing of the entire proceeding including the order of cognizance dated 20.11.2004 passed by the Judicial Magistrate, 1st class, Muzaffarpur in G.R. No.327 of 2004 (Trial No.2314 of 2007) arising out of Karja P.S. case No.28 of 2004. The case of the Informant is that he purchased a certain piece of land from the Petitioner on payment of money. He came in peaceful possession over the same. However, subsequently he found out that the same piece of land had been sold by the Petitioner to some other persons. So he vacated the land and instituted the present case. The submission of the Petitioner is that earlier the Petitioner Patna High Court Cr.Misc. No.49440 of 2007 dt.20-08-2013 2 had filed a Complaint against the Complainant vide Complaint case No.3025 of 2003 on 20.12.2003 and it appears that as a counter blast the present case has been filed by the Complainant so as to lay his claim upon the land which is now under ownership of another. Considering the various aspects of the case and the background facts, the application is allowed and the entire proceeding including the order dated 20.11.2004 passed by the Judicial Magistrate, 1st class, Muzaffarpur in G.R. No.327 of 2004 (Trial No.2314 of 2007) arising out of Karja P.S. case No.28 of 2004 is hereby set aside. (Anjana Prakash, J) NAFR/Narendra/-

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
