come up before this The matter The petitioner is Since he was not supplied tender paper he had to Honble Court.

During the pendency of the writ application, the respondent authorities informed the petitioner that in case the writ petition is withdrawn, he would be supplied tender papers etc. On that basis the writ petitioner withdrew the fiRs. writ petition which he moved and thereafter he was allowed to participate tender process and work order was issued in his favour.

in a He has completed Subsequently he was not supplied any tender paper for some unknown reason and the petitioners name was not featured in the list.

In the Affidavit in opposition a plea was taken that he did not participate in the tender process.

Learned counsel for the writ petitioner submits that tender papers were not supplied in time that is the reason for not participation.

the writ petitioner should be permitted to Therefore she submits that participate in the tender process.

She also submits that not a days the tender is invited through internet and leave may be granted in favour of the writ petitioner to get tender papers from internet and to submit the same subject to the final result of the writ petition.

It was submitted that if the tender is not submitted within a day then that will not be considered the submissions made.

Since nobody is appearing and I am inclined to keep the matter fixed on a separate date for giving an opportunity to the respondents to make their submissions, I grant leave to the writ petitioner to take the tender paper through internet and to submit the same.

However, submission of this tender writ paper is subject to result of the petition.

The writ petitioner will not be entitled to claim any equity in the event the case is decided against him.

This is without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the parties.

The matter is fixed on 20.9.2012.

The Advocate-on-record of the writ petitioner is directed to serve a notice upon Mr. Agarwal before the date fixed for hearing.
