20. In September, 2013 The petitioner has been made accused for the offence registered under Section 436/34 of the Indian Penal Code. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been implicated with sole intention to coerce the petitioner to compromise the case, lodged by her against the son of the informant and co-accused in Mohanpur P.S. Case No.175/2012, registered under Sections 376(2)(G) of the Indian Penal Code. It is further submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that co-accused, against whom similar allegation was made, has been granted bail by the learned Court below. However, the petitioner's bail was rejected as earlier this High Court had rejected A.B.A. No.859 of 2013 of the petitioner. Learned A.P.P while opposing the bail of the petitioner, has not controverted the submissions advanced by the petitioner's

counsel. In the aforesaid facts and circumstance of the case the petitioner above named, is directed to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Shri G. K. Tiwary, learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Deoghar in connection with Mohanpur P.S. Case No.392 of 2012 corresponding to G.R. No. 1514 of 2012. (Amitav K. Gupta, J.) Chandan/-

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
