23. d September, 2013 The petitioner has been made an accused for the offence registered under Sections 302, 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner had no knowledge that this case had been lodged against him and that the in-laws and the husband of the deceased have been acquitted in S.T. No. 16 of 2011 by order dated 19.10.2012. That the petitioner is in custody since 22.06.2013. Learned A.P.P while opposing the bail of the petitioner, has not controverted the submissions advanced by the petitioner's counsel. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstance of the case the petitioner above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Civil Judge, (Jr. Division), VI, Koderma in connection with Satgawan P.S. Case No. 23 of 2010 corresponding to G.R. No. 257 of 2010,

subject to the condition that the petitioner will remain present as and when directed by the trial Court till the conclusion of the trial. (Amitav K. Gupta, J.)
