JUDGMENT

Petitioners have approached this Court inter alia seeking the following reliefs: "(i) Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction to the 2nd respondent directing him to grant grace marks in sports quota to the petitioners and other similarly situated students on the basis of their performance and participation certificates issued by Kerala mountaineering Association in connection with the state level competitions held at National adventure Academy, Devikulam, Idukki from 28.3.2014 to 30.3.2014. (ii) To issue a direction to the 2nd respondent to extend the last date of awarding sports quota grace marks from 15th of May 2014 to 30th May 2014." 2. However, during the hearing of the matter, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the only W.P.C.No.12496/2014 2 relief sought for is for disposal of Ext.P6. Having heard the learned Government Pleader and having regard to the nature of contentions urged, I am of the view that the writ petition can be disposed of as under:
