(ORAL) Petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing respondents to adjust the petitioner as a Guest Faculty History Lecturer at Government Senior Secondary School Berli Khurd, District Rewari, in terms of order dated 30.03.2012 (Annexure P-4).Reliance has been placed upon the order passed by the Supreme Court on 19.10.2012 (Annexure P-7).according to which, it is asserted that Guest Teachers should be allowed to continue to function till the fresh appointments are made.

As per the facts of the case, petitioner had himself submitted an application for his relieving and adjustment in some Prerna datta 2014.08.14 14:07 I attest to the

Although his case has been recommended, according to him, for adjustment in some other school but the matter has not yet been finalized.

This plea of the petitioner cannot be accepted in the light of the subsequent order dated 26.03.2014 passed by the Supreme Court in Contempt Petition (C) No.420 of 2012 in SLP (C) 10818 of 2012 titled as Tilak Raj versus Arun Kumar Gupta and otheRs.Further, after the completion of the selection process by the Haryana School Teachers Selection Board and recommendations forwarded to the State of Haryana, appointments have been made/are being made.

If the prayer of the petitioner is accepted it would amount to violating the order of the Supreme Court in Tilak Raj's case (supra).Dismissed.
