(Prayer: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus to call for the records relating to the impugned order passed by the second respondent issued in proceedings in Na.Ka.No.m.2/c.,(C)8194/2007, and published in Tamil Nadu Government Gazettee No.11, Part VI Section 2 in No.VI(2)/148/2009, dated 25.03.2009 and confirmed in G.O(D)No.640 Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (P.R.IV) Department dated 11.11.2009 issued by the first respondent and quash the same and consequently reinstating the petitioner as President of the Kurunthampattu Panchayat, Kallal Panchayat Union, Sivagangai District.)

1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the counsel for the petitioner reports that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the matter and hence, the writ petition may be dismissed as not pressed. Mr.Anwar Sameem, who is representing the counsel on record, makes an endorsement to that effect.

2. In view of the endorsement, this writ petition is dismissed as not pressed. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is also dismissed.

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
