(Prayer: Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus calling for the records of the second respondent in his proceedings in Na.Ka.No.309/2010, dated 28.3.2013 and to quash the same as illegal and in violation of principles of laws and further to direct the third respondent to release the Document No.1655/2010, dated 09.07.2010 within the time stipulated by this Court.)
