Dated this the 14th day of December, 2022 This original petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India and the short prayer that has been pressed in this petition is to direct the learned Assistant Sessions Judge, Neyyattinkara, to expedite the trial and disposal of S.C.No.712/2016 (a under under the five plus old category), within a time fixed by this Court.

2. On 29.11.2022, this Court called for a report from the learned Assistant Sessions Judge, Neyyattinkara and the learned Assistant Sessions Judge reported as under:

I may humbly submit that the total pendency of this court is 3473 and out of it 780 are five year old cases. Apart from that the frequent arrival of direction for time bound disposal of new cases makes the working condition very hectic. So I may be excused for kept pending the case for such a long period. Six witnesses are cited by the prosecution out of it three are officials. Hence I may be granted minimum of three months for disposing the case.

3. In view of the above submission, the learned Assistant Sessions Judge, Neyyattinkara, is directed to dispose of S.C.No.712/2016, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this

judgment.
