The appellant was convicted for misappropriating the funds of the co-operative society being its secretary. However such irregularities took place in 1981-82 and the amount misappropriated was minor and the same was returned at that time only along with the interest. Considering the case, benevolent provisions of the Probation of offenders Act were extended to the appellant and was released on executing a bond before Trial Court for keeping peace and good behavior for 3 years.
