2. Mr.P.Gunaraj, learned counsel representing Mr.G.Vasudevan, takes notice on behalf of the respondents electricity board. By consent the writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

Mr.P.Gunaraj, learned counsel for the respondents on instruction from the first respondent Assistant Engineer, who is present in Court, produced a copy of proceedings No.f/vz; 2/bgh/,8-g-byl;Rkpg[uk; gphpt[-nfhg;g[vz; 42-m/vz; 418-11?12 dated 26.11.2011. The copy of the proceedings is served on the counsel for the petitioner today.

4. In view of the above proceedings passed by the second respondent, the petitioner is at liberty to challenge the same in accordance with law.
