Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the [Constitution of India](#) praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to effect Electricity Deposit Refund on the representation dated 28.5.2009 of the patentor's Package Company and the Wedding Hall situate at No.22, Aanjeeamman Koil Street, Anakaputhur, Chennai and Padmapriya Kalyana Mandapam, Vinoonha Nagar, Anakaputhur, Chennai for related relief.

ORDER

1. This Writ Petition is filed praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to effect Electricity Deposit Refund on the representation dated 28.5.2009 of the patentor's Package Company and the Wedding Hall situate at No.22, Aanjeeamman Koil Street, Anakaputhur, Chennai and Padmapriya Kalyana Mandapam, Vinoonha Nagar, Anakaputhur, Chennai for related relief.

2. Mr.P.Gunaraj, learned counsel takes notice on behalf of the respondents. By consent the writ petition is taken up for final disposal.

3. Petitioner made a representation dated 28.5.2009 to the respondents requesting electricity deposit refund. In view of the prayer sought for in this writ petition, without going into the merits of the petitioner's claim, if the representation dated 28.5.2009 is not disposed of already, the second respondent is directed to consider and dispose of the same expeditiously, preferably, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. The writ petition is disposed of as above. No costs.

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
