1. This Misc.Cvl. is filed by the counsel for Appellant, for condoning the delay of 357 days in filing the appeal.
2. I have heard learned counsel appearing for appellant and learned counsel appearing for Insurer.
3. The delay in filing the appeal has been satisfactorily explained by showing sufficient cause and the same is accepted.
