It is alleged in the First Information Report that the petitioners with  
their associates after forming an unlawful assembly, committed house trespass and  
caused assault to the informant and his family members.  
It is submitted that the specific allegation of causing assault is only  
against Santoshi Mahto and the allegation of theft is against Gyani Mahto, who are not the  
petitioner at present. As a matter of fact, the petitioners and the  
informant are the Gotias and they are having land dispute.  
Learned Counsel for the State has opposed the prayer. It seems that maximum  
numbers of family members of accused  
have been implicated with general and omnibus allegation.  
Considering the aforesaid aspect of the matter, the petitioners are  
directed to surrender before the court below within three weeks from today and  
if they do so they will be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/  
(Ten thousand) each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of  
Sri Sanjay Singh Yadav, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Hazaribagh in connection with  
Tati Hariya P.S. Case No. 11 of 2012, corresponding to G.R.No. 1052 of  
2012, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of
