raised objection that the present writ petition cannot be entertained in view of the
bar created by Article 329 of the Constitution, which provides not only bars to
interference by courts in electoral matters but also bars for interference in the
validity of any law relating to the delimitation of constituencies or the allotment
of seats to such constituencies made or purporting to be made under Article
327 or Article 328.. Learned counsel for the petitioner wants to satisfy this Court
that this petition can be entertained in spite of such bar created by Article 329(a).
