Mr. B.L. Choudhary, for the petitioner/s. ... By the order dated 31.5.2012, the Zonal Manager, Rajasthan State Road Transport Corporation, Jodhpur Zone, Jodhpur transferred the petitioner from Barmer depot to Jalore depot. While questioning, correctness of the same, it is stated that the petitioner is suffering from certain ailments, but without taking into consideration the same, impugned transfer has been effected. It is also pointed out that a representation was submitted by the petitioner, but the respondents did not consider the same. I do not find any merit in the argument advanced. It is well settled that transfer is a normal exigency of service and the courts are not required to interfere with the same until that is in violation of statute or is an outcome of malafides or extraneous considerations or is shockingly arbitrary. No such eventuality exists in the present matter. No other argument is advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner. The petition for writ is, therefore, dismissed. (GOVIND MATHUR) J.

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
