petitioner seeks bail in connection with a case registered under Section 302/34 of
the Indian Penal Code. Considering the fact that the specific allegation of causing

the petitioner and three others are alleged to have caught hold of the deceased
while he was sleeping, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on
