This is a petition for grant of regular bail for the offence under Sections 366A and 376/34 of the Indian Penal Code. The victim in her statement under Section 164 of the Cr. P. C. stated that she went along with one Ajay Kumar @ Paswan to Haryana and there the petitioners came. It is alleged that they were planning to sell, then she fled away. Ajay Kumar @ Paswan was facing trial and has been acquitted. Hence, having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.5,000/- (five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saharsa in connection with Saharsa Sadar P. S. Case No. 71
