24. 01-2012 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State. The petitioner has been arrested in connection with Jandaha P.S. Case No. 47 of 2011, registered for offence under Sections 307, 389, 341, 323, 324, 427, 507/34 of the Indian Penal Code. The occurrence alleged to have taken place as wife of Nagendra Singh and wife of the informant has contested election. There is allegation that Rs. 1100/- and a golden chain was snatched and assault. However the injury is simple. The petitioner is in custody since 29. 10.2011. Having regard to the fact and circumstance, the injury is simple in nature and there is dispute with regard to the election, hence the above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Patna High Court Cr.Misc.

No.3320 of 2012 (2) dt.24-01-2012 thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali, in connection with Jandaha P.S. Case No. 47 of 2011. (Gopal Prasad, J.) m.p.

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
