24. 01-2012 Petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences under Sections 420, 468, 120B, 323, 504/34 of the I.P.C. Accusation is of preparing fabricated deed with regard to the land in conspiracy with others. Initially the complaint was dismissed but in pursuance to the revisional order, cognizance has been taken. Considering the fact that in the background of land dispute the accusation has been levelled when others have been granted bail, let the petitioner namely Jago Devi, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class,
