24. 01-2012 Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the question whether the lease deed executed by the informant in favour of petitioner no. 1 is a forged one or not is in the nature of civil dispute and no prosecution can be maintained. Issue notice to the opposite party no. 2 by ordinary process as also by registered post with A/D to show cause as to why this application be not admitted for hearing or disposal of at the stage of admission itself. Requisites for issuance of notices must be filed within one week, failing which this application shall stand rejected

without further reference to a Bench. In the meantime, further proceeding in connection with Malaslami P.S. Case No. 136 of 2007 pending in the court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patna City shall remain stayed. Put up this case soon after service of notice. (Vikash Jain, J.)
