24. 01-2012 Petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences under Sections 419, 420 of the I.P.C. It is alleged against the petitioner that in his place at the Madhyama Examination, one Kamlesh Yadav was appearing. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that without his knowledge Kamlesh Yadav was appearing. Considering the fact that petitioner is student and was not apprehended at the place of examination, let the petitioner namely Harendra Yadav, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Buxar in
