24. 01-2012 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State. Petitioners are named accused in this case of assault. Submission is, apart from others, plea of alibi and it is further submitted that counter version by way of Complaint Case no. 598 of 2011 the injuries sustained are simple in nature on non-vital parts. Petitioners have no criminal

antecedent. If it is so, the petitioners, in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate, Siwan, in Maharajganj P.S.Case no.88 of 2011, subject to the conditions laid down in 2 Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure with additional condition that the petitioners shall remain present before the court below on each and every dates for two years or till disposal of the case, whichever is earlier. In case of failure to remain present on two consecutive dates without reasonable explanation, the privilege granted shall be deemed to be cancelled. (Akhilesh Chandra, J) Aftab Ahmad/-

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
