IN THE HIGH COURT OF JUDICATURE AT PATNA Criminal Miscellaneous No.3136 of 2012 Suresh Prasad, S/o. Ramdhaji Prasad, resident of Vill. Khijirpura, P. S. Kesariya, Distt. East Champaran. Petitioner. Versus The State of Bihar Opp. Party. ----- 02/ 24.01.2012 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State. This is a petition for regular bail for the offence under Sections 302/34 and 328 of the Indian Penal Code. The petitioner is the father-in-law of the deceased Ashok Prasad. There is no eye-witness to the occurrence and there is no witness to suggest as to who administered poison and the chemical examination also does not corroborate the accusations. Hence, having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Kesariya P.
