This Court by order dated 16.4.2008 had directed the counsel for the University to file a comprehensive counter affidavit, wherein, it was also asked to explain the case of Jai Nath Jha and Amar Nath Jha as stated by the petitioner in paragraph nos. 19 & 20 of the writ application. Despite expiry of a period of four years, no counter affidavit has been filed by the University. In that view of the matter, this Court would direct for personal appearance of the Registrar of the Lalit Narayan Mithila University to explain as to why he should not be punished for committing contempt of this Court. List this case on 2.2.2012 when the Registrar of the University must remain 2 personally present.
