The petitioner is in custody in connection with Complaint Case No.1207 of 2010 for offences punishable under sections 307 and 498A of the Indian Penal Code and section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act. Learned counsel for the petitioner with reference to a petition filed under section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, placed at Annexure-4 of this application, submits that the present complaint case is an afterthought and has been filed on 24.9.2010 one month after the divorce case was filed by the present petitioner.
