In a Complaint Case lodged by wife against the petitioner in which he has been made accused under Section 498A of the Indian Penal Code and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act. Submission is that the petitioner is in custody since 26.08.2011 and he has properly behaved with his wife. He has tried his best to give the complainant full dignity and love but she is denying the company of the petitioner. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/court concerned, Nawada in connection with Complaint Case No. 79 of 2009.
