IN THE HIGH COURT OF JUDICATURE AT PATNA Criminal Miscellaneous No.813 of 2012 Sanju Devi Versus The State Of Bihar -----
02. 11.01.2012 Petitioner being wife of the brother of the husband is apprehending her arrest in a case registered for the offences under Sections 304B, 201/34 of the I.P.C. The accusations are of demand of dowry and torture. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the victim died due to illness which gets reflected from the doctors prescriptions contained in Annexure-2. Considering the fact that specific accusation is against the husband who is dead now, let the petitioner namely Sanju Devi, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Patna City, Patna in connection with Malsalami P.S.
