11. 01-2012 The present writ petition has been filed by way of public interest litigation commanding and directing the respondents to stop implementation of the scheme by which they have decided to settle a Mahadalit Basti on the Gair

Majarua Aam Land. It has also been stated by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner that a representation dated 29.10.2011 contained in Annexure 4 to that effect is filed by the petitioner to the Additional District Magistrate, Patna, but the same is still pending till today. Having heard counsel for the State, it would suffice if a direction is issued to respondent no. 4, the Additional District Magistrate, Patna to dispose of the representation dated 29.10.2011 as contained in Annexure 4, if already not disposed of, in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible, after hearing all the parties concerned.
