11. 01.2012 On the matter being remitted back from this Court, the Appellate Authority has held the enquiry, has noticed the petitioner as well as respondent no.13 and has given them opportunity to produce certificates in respect of their rival claim that they are 2 actually Chandra Mohan Singh and other person is impersonating as such. After looking to the materials produced by the parties, it has held that the respondent no.13 is the genuine Chandra Mohan Singh and this petitioner, who claims to be Chandra Mohan Singh, is actually Ramanand Singh and own brother of the said Chandra Mohan Singh. The findings of the Appellate Authority are on facts and based on materials and documents placed before it which this Court finds as correct. Hence, this Court does not find any valid grounds for interference with the same. The writ application is accordingly dismissed. Arvind/ (J.N. Singh, J.)

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
