The lady petitioner is one of the named accused of the case which has been registered under Sections 363, 366A/34 of the Indian Penal Code. The informants minor daughter disappeared and she was later on married with Congress Yadav. Submission is that the petitioner is Mosi of the victim. In fact, the informants daughter Rubi Kumari has married with Congress Yadav and she is happily living in his house. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the 2 learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate/court concerned, Danapur (Patna) in connection with Sigori P.S.
