For the State : APP. ----- 02/ 11.01.2012 Heard learned Counsel for the petitioner and the State. This application has been filed for modification of the order dated 02.12.2011 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 40507 of 2011 by which the petitioner has been granted bail but the surname of the petitioner was typed Singh in place of Prasad as the same was mentioned in the application. The actual name of the petitioner is Shushil Prasad which is apparent from the fact that Vakalatnama was endorsed in his name. Considering the submission, name of the petitioner stands modified to the extent that it shall be deemed to have been passed in connection with Shushil Prasad and not in connection with Shushil Singh. This modification application is allowed. Other terms and conditions of the 2 order dated 02.12.2011 in Cr. Misc. No. 40507 of 2011 would remain same. Let the order be transmitted through Fax to the learned Sessions Judge/court concerned, Bhojpur at Ara in connection with N.D.P.S. Case No. 13 of 2011, arising out of Bihiya P.S.
