25. 01-2012 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State. The petitioner has renewed his prayer for bail in connection with Industrial P.S. Case No. 36/09, G. R. No. 2084 of 2009/Tr. No. 08 of 2010 registered for the offence under Sections 20, 22 and 25 of the N.D. P.S. Act. Recovery is of 33 Kg. 900 Grams of Ganja. It is submitted that now evidence has come that place of recovery does not belong to the petitioner. Considering the fact that recovery is of commercial quantity and the fact that the trial is going on, this Court is not inclined to revise my

earlier order. However, it is expected from the learned trial court to conclude the trial within a Patna High Court Cr.Misc. No.1171 of 2012 (2) dt.25-01-2012 period of nine months and if the trial will not be concluded within a period of nine months, petitioner will be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail. With this observation, this application is rejected again. Let the order be faxed to the learned C.J.M., Bhagalpur in connection with Industrial P.S. Case No. 36/09, G. R. No. 2084/09/Tr.
