25. 01-2012 Petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences under Sections 302/34 of the I.P.C. There is general accusation of assaulting the father of the informant. There is no specific accusation of assault against the petitioner. The postmortem report reflects one incise external injury. Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner namely Ramanuj Singh, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Danapur, Patna in connection with Paliganj P.S.
