25. 01-2012 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered under Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code. Jha sold the iron to this petitioner. A supplementary affidavit has been filed that the petitioner has no scrap business and has no criminal antecedent. weeks from today, on furnishing the bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-divisional Judicial Magistrate, Birpur, Supaul In connection with Raghapur P.S. Case No. 35 of 2011 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C. (Dinesh Kumar Singh, J.) Amrendra/-
