25. 01-2012 Petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offences under Sections 341, 323, 325, 308 of the I.P.C. It is alleged that due to the fight between children of both sides, petitioner made assault and ultimately pierced stick into the eye of the grand daughter of the informant. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that for the occurrence of 03.09.2011 the F.I.R. was lodged on 16.09.2011 and the order of the Sessions Judge reflects that final injury report has not been brought on record till date. Delayed lodging of the F.I.R. clouds the bona fide of the accusation, let the petitioner namely Jagdamba Devi, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.

10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gopalganj in connection with Fulwariya P.S. Case No. 162 of 2011. (Dinesh Kumar Singh, J.) Shageer/-
