IN THE HIGH COURT OF JUDICATURE AT PATNA Criminal Miscellaneous No.1204 of 2012 Suresh Ram Versus The State Of Bihar ----- with Criminal Miscellaneous No.2171 of 2012 Hemant Ram @ Ashutosh Jee Versus The State Of Bihar ----- 2/25.1.2012 Heard Mr. A.K. Sah, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr. Uma Shankar Pd. Singh, learned counsel for the State. The petitioners are languishing in custody since 12.8.2011 in a case registered under sections 25(1-b)a, 26 and 35 of the Arms Act and section 17 of the C.L.A. Act. From petitioner Suresh Ram, one red banner and a mobile were recovered. The said mobile was claimed by the petitioner Suresh of his own. From petitioner Hemant Ram alias Ashutosh Jee, one loaded country made pistol was recovered. Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing the bail bond of Rs.10000/(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of C.J.M.
