23. 01-2012 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State. The petitioner has been arrested in connection with Dhangai P.S. Case No. 51 of 2011 registered for offence under Section 414 of the Indian Penal Code. It is alleged that the petitioner was caught while going on motorcycle and some articles were recovered from the said motorcycle which is part and parcel of the F.I.R. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody since 08.

10. 2011 and there is nothing to suggest that articles were recovered from the motorcycle or seizure list prepared which are part and parcel of theft property. Under the facts and circumstance of the case, the above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten

thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Patna High Court Cr.Misc. No.3279 of 2012 (2) dt.23-01-2012 Judicial Magistrate, Bhojpur at Ara, in connection with Dhangai P.S. Case No. 51 of 2011. (Gopal Prasad, J.) m.p.

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
