23. 01-2012 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State. Petitioner being husband of the deceased is languishing in jail custody in a case registered under Sections 304 B, 201/34 of the Indian Penal Code. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that in course of investigation, it came to light that deceased along with her one and half years old child committed suicide and after the aforesaid incident, proper information regarding the death of the deceased was given to her father as well as other family members but when the informant reached at the village of the

petitioner he lodged the present case and the police without giving any weightage to the statements of witnesses as well as circumstances of the case submitted charge- sheet under Section 304 B of the Indian Penal Code.
