23. 01-2012 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State. Petitioner is in jail custody since 6.6.2011 in a case registered under sections 20, 22, 23 and 24 of the NDPS Act. Admittedly, alleged recovery has been made from the dicky of the bus and the same has not been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner.
