23. 01-2012 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State. The petitioner is languishing in custody since 18.08.2011 in a case registered for the offence under Sections 399, 402, 414, 120B of the Indian Penal Code and 25(1-B)A, 26 and 35 of the Arms Act. From petitioners possession, two motorcycles and mobile were recovered. It is submitted that seizure list reflects that motorcycles were seized from the road and seized mobile was not put on T. I. Parade. The statement has been made in the petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the Patna High Court Cr.Misc.
